Community Connections offers programs for people who want to explore new educational areas and development their skills for both professional and personal reasons. Every effort is made to create a pleasant learning environment with accommodating technology and facilities.

Community Connections develops and administers classes, workshops, seminars, and specialized training opportunities designed to fit the needs of all our customers. We welcome and encourage inquiries and suggestions regarding future classes and programs. Courses are added as needs and interests are identified. If you have a new course idea, contact FHTC's Business & Industry Training Center to explore the possibility of offering the class. Community Connections classes have served the needs of regional business & industry, non-profit organizations, professionals, budding entrepreneurs, hobbyists in a myriad of areas. Learners range from 6 to 106 in age (almost!), and all share an interest in learning and self improvement.

Classes are usually held at our main campus, 3301 W. 18th Ave., in Emporia, KS, but may also be held in a variety of other locations, depending on the needs of the class.

We run four terms each year, and we generally plan about 3 months in advance. The fall term runs from September - November, the winter term from December - February, the spring term from March - May, and the summer term from June - August. Classes meet for as few as one or as many as sixteen sessions.

Class Proposal Deadlines:

Fall term - June 1

Winter term - September 1

Spring term - December 1

Summer term - March 1

The fees for Community Connections classes vary according to number of class hours, minimum number of students, facilitator costs and materials. Every effort is made to keep costs down so that our courses are accessible to the entire community.

We employ a variety of methods to market our classes. The biggest emphasis is on our Community Connections quarterly catalog. The catalog is mailed to area households and distributed to area businesses approximately 5 weeks before classes begin. Information about our classes can also be found in the Emporia Gazette, on Channel 8, and on KVOE.
