## Welcome Back Wranglers

We have been busy this summer preparing for the fall semester and are looking forward to having everyone back on campus.

During the summer, we worked on several infrastructure projects. Two that will be very impactful for our students are the renovation of the Dental Assisting and Practical Nursing lab areas. The new Dental Assisting lab is double the size of the previous lab and includes technology upgrades. The Practical Nursing lab was also renovated, and students will have the opportunity to obtain skills with the newly acquired maternal simulation mannequin. These upgrades and investments in technology lead to enhanced learning opportunities for our students, one of our main goals.

We're also expanding options for students by offering a new program and new location beginning this fall. Our new program, Hospitality Dietary Management, combines culinary skills with nutrition and health knowledge, a very versatile program. In addition to be available on our main campus, Automotive Technology will now also be offered in Garnett, Kansas. Bret Pope, long-time FHTC instructor, will be working with students there.

On our Foundation front, the Inspiring Wranglers: The Campaign for Tomorrow's Chefs continued to gain ground over the summer. Our current total is \$1.2 million, and we anticipate a strong continuation of the campaign this fall.

Good things are happening and it's an exciting time to be a part of the FHTC family. See you on campus.

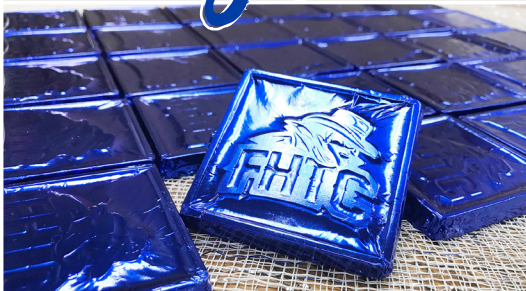
