

## FHTC sees increased enrollment again

Flint Hills Technical College's full-time equivalent enrollment was 699 for the 2019 fall semester 20th day report released by the Kansas Board of Regents, an increase of 2.08% from 2018. FHTC's overall headcount was 1,514, up from 1,425 at the same time last year. FHTC's headcount has increased 81.75% since 2014.

With three campuses in Emporia and an Automotive Training Center in Garnett, FHTC offers 20 programs of study in the areas of arts, health, information technology and industry technology. FHTC has a placement rate of 98%, of 206 contacted, 202 respondents are employed or continuing their education.
