

KCWE is an organization that promotes professional development for postsecondary career and technical education faculty and administrators. The Inside the Field award recognizes any KCWE member who has developed model programs, provided leadership, conducted research, or been involved in any other activity that advances the status and visibility of career and technical education within Kansas or beyond.



Dhority's career at FHTC has done just that. Coming to the college in 2011 following a 32 year career as a high school teacher, Dhority's leadership has been key in many areas including the growth of academic partnerships between FHTC and area high schools, adding several new 2+2 academic agreements with 4-year institutions, and aiding in the increase and advance of online courses.
