#### Things to buy now:

- Welding pliers/Welpers \$20
- 8" Slip Joint Pliers (WILDE is recommended) \$15
- Tip Cleaner \$7
- Single flint striker (Shurlite is recommended) \$8
- Tungsten (2% thoriated 3/32 or E3 3/32) 10 pcs \$20-\$50
