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Ford Motor Company Donates Car to Automotive Program

John North Ford, working with Ford Motor Company, presented Flint Hills Technical College's Automotive Technology program with a 2014 Ford Fiesta on September 10 at FHTC's main campus. The vehicle will be used to provide students with hands-on training in the lab, helping prepare them for their careers.

Marcus Hicks, Ford Regional Technical Talent Placement Specialist, who helped facilitate the donation worked with Ron Carlson, owner of John North Ford, and the FHTC Foundation. Hicks spoke about the supportive relationship the local dealership has with the College and the fact that the dealership currently employs 13 FHTC Automotive Technology grads.

"I received a call from Ron, and he said 'What do we got to do to get the deal done,' " remarked Hicks about the persuasiveness of Carlson.

The car is donated through the Ford Automotive Career Exploration program, a partnership program between Ford Motor Company, educational institutions, franchised dealerships and local communities. The intent of the program is to raise awareness and increase interest in career opportunities within the automotive industry.

"About 20% of our technicians will be eligible to retire in the next five years," said Brad Wilson, Ford Regional Parts and Service Operations Manager, speaking during the presentation about the need for more trained technicians, the need greater now than even six months ago.

Representatives from Ford Motor Company, John North Ford and the Emporia community joined FHTC administration, instructors and students at the Emporia campus for the presentation. Following the presentation, students were able to learn more about job opportunities in the automotive industry.


