

CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grant for Students Update as of December 31, 2022

Flint Hills Technical College has signed and returned the Certification and Agreement for the CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grant for Students in the amount of \$1,081,597 to the Department of Education.

CARES: \$500 has been made available to each Title IV eligible spring 2020 student and an additional \$500 - \$1,000 is available for students who are required to complete extended clinical hours beyond the regularly scheduled school year as of September 30, 2020

Emergency financial aid funds for students affected by the COVID-19 pandemic are available through the federal government as part of the CARES Act. Eligibility was limited to currently enrolled full-time or part-time FHTC undergraduate students during spring 2020.

CRRSAA: \$825 was disbursed to each degree seeking, half-time or more Title IV applicant enrolled during spring 2021 as of June 30, 2021

ARP: \$100 per credit hour was disbursed to each undergraduate student enrolled during summer 2021 and \$160 per credit hour was disbursed to each undergraduate student during fall 2021 as of December 31, 2021

FHTC has estimated that there are currently 527 students eligible to receive the funding. As of September 30, 2021, a total of \$1,121,726 has been disbursed to 691 students from all federal relief funding.
